As you are aware, Livingston Classical Academy's charter requires a portion of our students' education to have a cyber component. Hopefully you are more acutely aware of LCA's commitment to partner with parents in the education of your children. These two unique aspects of our school are perfectly suited for the health course required by the state of Michigan. As a parent, you have the opportunity to discuss the instruction presented in these on-line classes with your child as they complete them under your direct supervision.

The online health courses are for all students from Kindergarten through 9th grade. Lower-School (K-6) parents should simply follow the discussion prompts with their children. Upper-School students need to discuss their lessons with you and also submit short-answer responses to the lesson prompts.

All lessons and assessments can be found under the "Student" tab on the LCA website.

Once Lower School students complete a lesson, parents should fill out the form in the same website tab indicating the completion of the lesson. Lower School teachers will complete follow-up discussions in school.

Upper-school students need to submit their assessments on a weekly basis and will be indicated in LCA's weekly newsletter.
